Online Enrollments for 2018

Just a reminder that 4-H enrollments are due by **April 1, 2018.** Please make sure you see your advisor for your log in information. If you know what you are planning to take for the 2018 fair, please enter your enrollment, DON'T wait until the last minute.

As these are being entered online, the April 1st deadline applies and the online registration will close at midnight on April 1, 2018. Please don't wait until the last minute to enroll!

Remember the following key points when completing online enrollments:

- 1. Make sure you look over your projects that you will be taking this year.
- 2. DELETE any projects that you will NOT be taking for this program year.
- 3. Please do not create duplicate accounts.
- 4. For your Cloverbuds (kids that are age 5 **and** in kindergarten up to age 7), please select project #710.

Essay Requirements: Maintain anonymity; do not reveal your name, club name or advisor's name

Deadline: April 1, 2018 - Due to the Extension Office by 4:30 pm A \$500 scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the Honor's Night Banquet

How to Apply: Submit a one-page 500 word essay on "What do you see are the opportunities and/or challenges facing the dairy/beef industry today?", double spaced with Arial 12 font

Please include a cover page with the following: First and Last Name, Your Post-Secondary Plans, Name of 4-H Club, Email Address and Phone Number and List of Livestock Projects You Have Shown.



Gurgol Family Scholarship

A new scholarship is available! This scholarship is based on need for a graduating senior and current 4-H member of a horse club, who plans to commute to a local college/university, or online accredited program from home, during his/her freshman year.

Deadline: April 1, 2018 – Due to the Extension Office by 4:30 p.m.

Sign-In: Starts at 6:00 p.m. **Program** Starts: 6:30 p.m.

Junior Fair exhibitors are **required** to attend **one** of the Quality Assurance programs. Junior Fair Exhibitors of the following animals are required to attend:

- Dairy Cattle
- > Feeder Calves Beef and Dairy
- Market Steers/Heifers
- > All Goats (Pygmy, Market, Dairy, Boer, and all other breeds)
- Market Lambs
- Market Hogs
- > Poultry
- Rabbits * Requirement by the Ohio State Department of Agriculture (Projects #225, #226, #227)

REGARDLESS of a Junior Fair exhibitor's age, a PARENT MUST attend the Quality Assurance Program.

REGARDLESS of age, Junior Fair exhibitors shall successfully complete the Quality Assurance Program not less than 45 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition in which they will participate. <u>In Butler County, the deadline to complete a Quality Assurance Program is Friday, June 1, 2018.</u>

Statewide Quality Assurance Programs are NOT accepted.

What happens if a Junior Fair exhibitor misses all three Quality Assurance Programs? Junior fair exhibitors/parents are encouraged to attend a Butler County Quality Assurance Program. If you are unable to attend a Butler County Quality Assurance Program, you may attend a Quality Assurance Program in another county. You will need to provide Kevin Harris with proof of attendance of an out of county Quality Assurance Program by 4:30 PM on Friday June 1, 2018.

Flower order forms are due to the OSU Extension Office by April 10, 2018. Advisors, please make sure you use the master tally sheet when you turn in your order. Please make sure you bring all of your money with you.

A club check will be issued to the **club**, usually within the next 30 days. Also remember, the checks have a "Void after 90 days" on them, so make sure to cash them promptly as the office will not reissue any checks. **Click here** for the flower forms.

Book orders are placed every Friday. As we approach April 1st and after, it will take close to a month to receive books back. So, if you know what you would like to order, stop by the office and place your order soon.

Also remember, if your club has a checking account and a Sales Tax Exemption form on file, the club can order your books tax free, with a club check. If you stop in to order them without this, you will be charged sales tax.
