

Butler County 4-H Advisor's 4-H Committee Application

Deadline: NOVEMBER 1st

Applications from 4-H Advisors to serve on the 4-H Committee are to be submitted to the OSU Extension Office on or before November 1st. The 4-H Committee is an advisory committee to the OSU Extension Educator-4-H Youth Development. The 4-H Committee members will have term limits (4-H committee members will have a maximum of six year term limits) as set in the 4-H Committee's by-laws to ensure 4-H advisors an opportunity to serve for a determined time limit. The 4-H Committee members are to attend meetings, work on standing committees, and work with Extension staff members in promoting 4-H programming across Butler County.

4-H Advisors are encouraged to complete this application and submit it so a ballot can be composed for elections to the 4-H Committee can be held at the annual 4-H meeting in December. At the 4-H annual meeting, advisors are given changes to curricula, revisions to membership forms, deadlines for submitting paperwork, exhibit changes, and changes from the Junior Fair Board. This is a very important meeting for 4-H Advisors to attend.
