The FCS Department is offering 3 new classes with fun sewing projects you'll make at home!

All classes are FREE over Zoom meetings.

Each class will have a Friday evening prep session followed by a Saturday sewing session. Sewers **must attend the prep session** to take part in the sewing class.

To take part you'll need:

- Zoom capable device
- A men's button down shirt size medium or larger
- Sewing Machine
- Thread
- Scissors for fabric
- Pins or clips
- Ruler and/or yardstick
- Washable marker or chalk
- Iron
- Pencil and paper for notes
- Paper or cardboard to make a pattern



Class 1: Shirt Pillow – make a pillow cover from a man's shirt!

Prep class Friday Jan 29 at 6:30pm

Sewing class Saturday Jan 30 at 9am or 1pm

(this project requires a 20 inch or smaller square pillow form)



Class 2&3: Cuff ID Holder & Rice Warmer Bag – use a shirt cuff to make an ID holder & use a shirt sleeve to make a cozy rice warming bag!

Prep class Friday Feb 5 at 6:30pm

Sewing class Saturday Feb 6 at 9am or 1pm

(this project requires 1-2 pounds of rice to fill your bag)
