WRISTBANDS

There is a \$5.00 fee for wristbands, payable in cash on the day the Junior Fair member picks it up. Only one wristband per eligible member and advisor, who must personally show up to have the wristband put on by Fair Board staff. Wristbands will only be put on days and times listed below. All other times will have a cost of \$20.00 per wristband.

Wednesday - July 18th - 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. – Multi-Purpose building

Thursday - July 19th - 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - Multi-Purpose building

Friday – July 20th - 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. - Multi-Purpose building

Saturday – July 21st - 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. - Multi-Purpose building

Your wristband must be worn as a form of security and admission onto the fairgrounds. Wristbands must stay on all week or as long as you plan on coming back to the fair. If wristband is cut, taped, stretched or pried, it will not be honored at the gate and admission will be charged. All replacement wristbands will cost \$20.00.
