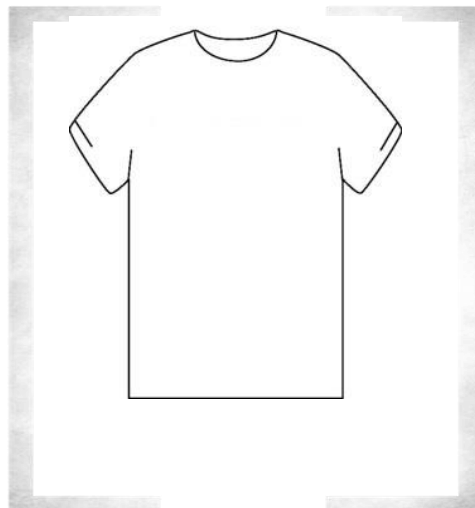
4-H T-Shirt Design Contest

The Butler County 4-H program is looking for a new design and phrase to promote 4-H that will be on the 2019 4-H t-shirts. Please think about a creative way to market 4-H on a t-shirt. You never know, your design just might be the winning entry that everyone will be wearing at the 2019 Butler County Fair!

The winning t-shirt design entry will receive \$25.00. This contest is open to all age groups of 4-H members.

T-Shirt Contest Guidelines:

1. Submit on 8.5 x 11 inch sheet of paper.
2. Can be hand drawn or computer generated.
3. Can be no more than two colors.
4. If you use the 4-H clover logo, make sure it has the patent number.
5. Entries are due: **March 1, 2019.**



Thank-you Note Card Contest

We are having a Thank-you Note Card contest in 2019 for 4-H members to design thank-you note cards for Butler County. Entries are due: **March 1, 2019.**

Get your creative juices flowing and come up with a design that you think would be an impressive 4-H thank-you note card. They can be hand drawn or computer generated. They should be submitted on a ½ sheet of paper (8 ½ x 5 ½).

Please turn in your entry by 4:30 p.m. on March 1st to the OSU Extension Office. **Put your name and club on the BACK of your entry.**

Three note cards will be selected and the winners will each receive \$25.00. The winning 4-H thank-you note cards will be used at 4-H functions and at the Butler County fair.



Cabbage Contest AND Cloverbud Fruit-Veggie Car Race

Both events will take place again this year. **Registration is not yet open.** However, you **MUST be enrolled into the 2019 4-H program year to be able to register** once registration opens up.

2019 Cabbage Contest

We will be doing the cabbage contest during the Butler County Fair again this year! However, the registration will be a little different this year. This is open to the **first 100 registrations only**. After 100 people have registered, it will close so don't delay!

Registration will open on March 1st!

To register, follow these steps:

1. You will need to log into the 4-H Online system under your family account
2. Click on **"My Member List"**
3. Click on **"Register A Member In An Event"**
4. Click on the drop down box and find the name of the youth and then the **"Grow the Biggest Cabbage Contest"**
5. Select the age group for the youth
6. Follow the steps from there



Cabbage Plant Pick-Up will be on **April 15, 2019** at the Butler County Extension Office.

Cloverbud Veggie-Fruit Derby Car Event

Again this year, cloverbuds will be able to participate in a Veggie-Fruit Derby Car Event. The race will take place at the Swine Barn that is located to the left of the Small Animal Barn. Enroll at 4-H Online – Registration Deadline – April 1st

The 4-H enrollment deadline - April 1st - will be here before we know it! Please take a few minutes to go into 4-H Online and get enrolled into the 2019 4-H program year.

You will re-enroll just as you enrolled yourselves last year. You log into the system using your “family” email address and password from last year. If you’ve forgotten your password, just click the link “forgot my password” and the system will send you a new one. Then, once you log in, you will be directed to set a new password.

Please remember to type in the entire “family” email address. **DO NOT auto-fill** it when it starts to pop up. The system will not let you log in that way.
