May 1, 2019, 6:00 p.m. registration - 6:30 p.m. program starts
Junior Fair exhibitors are required to attend one of the Quality Assurance programs. Junior Fair Exhibitors of the following animals are required to attend:

- Dairy Cattle
- Feeder Calves Beef and Dairy
- Market Steers/Heifers
- All Goats (Pygmy, Market, Dairy, Boer, and all other breeds)
- Market Lambs
- Market Hogs
- Poultry
- Rabbits * Requirement by the Ohio State Department of Agriculture (Projects #225, #226, #227)



Extremely Important!

All programs will take place at the Butler County Fairgrounds located at 1715 Fairgrove Avenue and State Route 4, Hamilton, Ohio 45011.

REGARDLESS of a Junior Fair Exhibitors age, a PARENT must attend the Quality Assurance Program.

REGARDLESS of age, Junior Fair Exhibitors shall successfully complete the Quality Assurance Program not less than 45 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition in which they will participate. In Butler County the deadline to complete a Quality Assurance Program and submit your documentation to Kevin Harris is June 3, 2019.

Statewide Quality Assurance Programs are not accepted.
