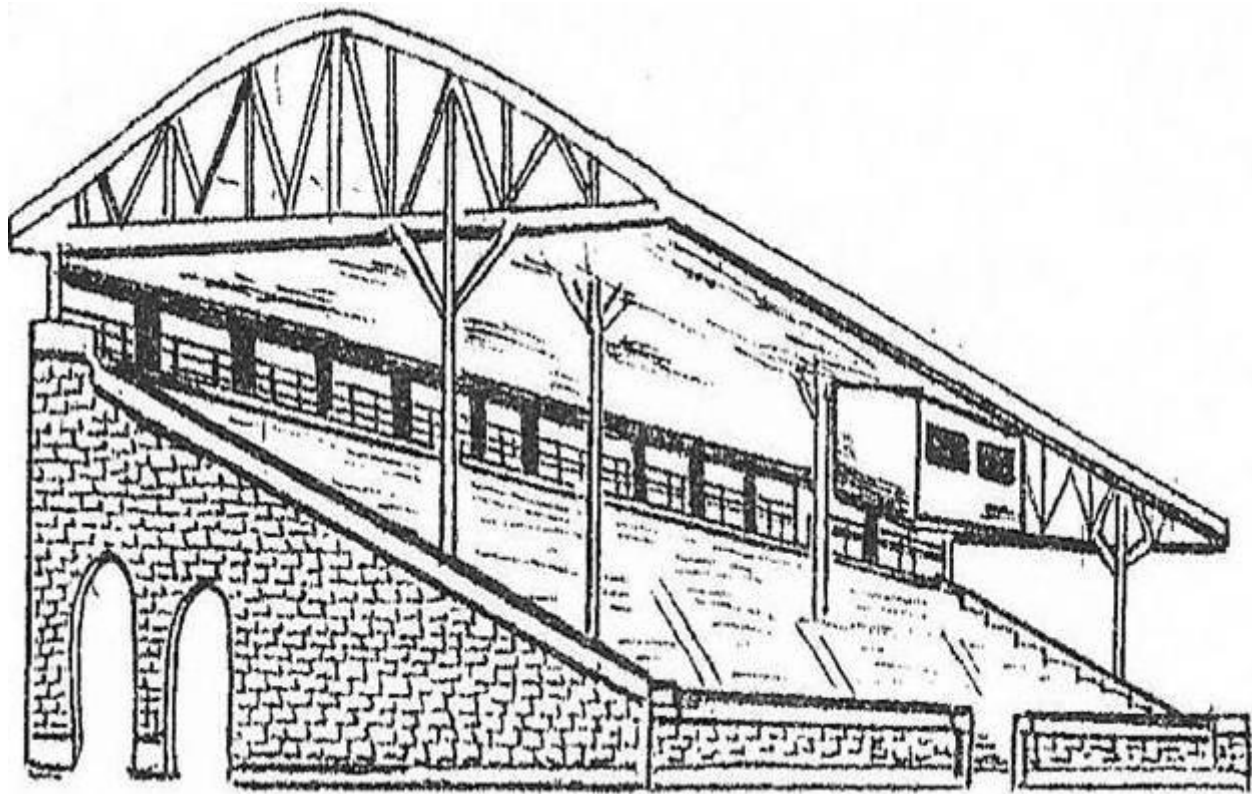

*Amateur Radio "Kids Day"*  
*Saturday, June 15, 2019 2 PM to 8 PM*

"Kids Day" is an event to encourage young people to have fun with amateur radio whether they are licensed or not. It is an introduction to "ham radio" to give on-the-air experience to youngsters and hopefully foster interest for them in the amateur radio hobby.

"Kids Day" is sponsored by the American Radio Relay League (ARRL), the national association for amateur radio, and hosted by many amateur radio clubs around the country.

On Saturday, June 15, 2019 2 PM to 8 PM, kids around the country will be chatting with other kids, not via the Internet or cell phones, but over the airwaves using amateur radio.

The Hamilton Amateur Radio Club (HAMARC) will be hosting "Kids Day" at our station at a historic amateur radio and broadcast radio site at 329 North C Street in Hamilton, OH from 2 PM to 8 PM Saturday, June 15, 2019.

In addition to operating our amateur radio station where kids can get on the air and talk to other kids, we will be showing some short videos of kids operating their "ham" radios and making contacts with other "hams" and participating in amateur radio contests.

Kids who participate in "Kids Day" will receive a personalized "certificate of participation" with their name printed before they leave.

Since we will be showing the videos and operating our station indoors, this is a rain or shine event.
