SERVSAFE® TRAINING FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD STAFF

Stay in compliance by earning your ServSafe® Manager certificate with other early childhood staff in a course designed just for you. The training will provide accurate, up-to-date information for all levels of employees on all aspects of handling food, from receiving and storing to preparing and serving. This course is designed to provide food service managers, operators, and owners with updated principles of safe food handling. Upon successful completion of the course and exam, participants receive a Certificate of Completion from ServSafe® and Certification in Food Protection from the Ohio Department of Health.
