- 2. Each individual registered will receive two email messages after registering. One will come from TAP Series and the other one will be from OSUE (minor.81@osu.edu) with a username and password with the link allowing access to the online class.
- 3. Student takes the online class (about 2-4 weeks) **and** prints the Certificate of Completion.
- 4. On the day of exam, student must bring to the OSUE office:
 - Copy of the Certificate, indicating completion of the online training and
 - Picture / photo ID
- 5. Student takes the ServSafe® Manager Exam on their pre-selected date at the OSUE, Butler County office, located at 1802 Princeton Road, Ste. #400, Hamilton, OH 45011, proctored by an OSUE staff member, who will submit the exam answer sheet to the National Restaurant Association to be graded.
- 6. When the student passes the exam, a ServSafe® certificate can be printed at: ServSafe.com. The State of Ohio certificate will be emailed to student from an OSUE staff member.
- 7. Exam begins at scheduled time. Once exam begins, you will not be admitted and will need to reschedule.
- 8. Access to online classes expire in 6 months from date of activation. No refunds will be given for failure to complete online class within that 6 month time period.
