What is ServSafe® Manager?

ServSafe® Manager has become the industry standard in food-safety training and is accepted in almost all United States jurisdictions that require employee certification.

The 12 hour ServSafe® Manager program provides accurate, up-to-date information for all levels of employees on all aspects of handling food, from receiving and storing to preparing and serving.

This course is designed to provide food service managers, operators, and owners with updated principles of safe food handling. The principles learned in this course can easily be applied and practiced by all food service workers.

Upon successful completion of the course and exam, participants receive a Certificate of Completion from ServSafe® and Certification in Food Protection from the Ohio Department of Health.

Class Time: 8:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. (Participants arriving more than 15 minutes after the start of class will need to reschedule at an additional fee of \$50.00)

NOTES:

- The ServSafe® exam can be taken twice within a 30 day period. If a 3rd attempt is required, the examinee must wait at least 60 days from their last attempt.
- You must complete training and testing within 6 months from registration.
- A ServSafe® Proctor must be present to administer the ServSafe® Food Safety Manager Certification Exam.
- Exam Re-testing Fee: \$75.00 per person.
 You do not need to retake the entire course to retest.
- A passing score of 70% is required to earn certification.
- Exam will be given at the end of the 2nd day
- Participant MUST attend the two consecutive days to be eligible to take the certification exam
- You must provide a valid photo ID to take the exam.

*** Cancellation Policy ***

Registration fees cannot be refunded!

If notification of your inability to attend is received prior to the first class of the two-day program, your paid registration will be honored at any subsequent ServSafe® class offered by OSU Extension, Butler County within the next six months.
