Our Vision

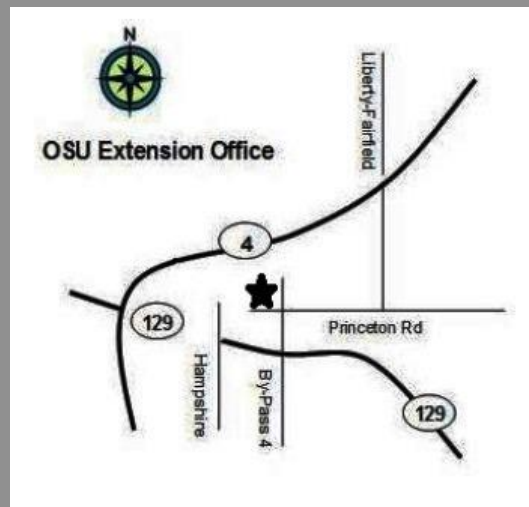
